1) Traffic Restrictions at Motor and National

Guests from Motor Avenue Improvement Association and Westside Neighborhood Council

*MOTION: The Palms Neighborhood Council supports the Motor Avenue Improvement Association's proposal presented to Council District 5 on April 19, 2011, specifying that the City of Los Angeles should:*

- 1. Remove items #18-21 of the CCNTMP associated with setting a 600 vehicle per hour cap during AM & PM peak hours on Motor Avenue by altering signal timing and installing "No Left Turn" LED sign at Motor and National.*
- 2. Instruct LADOT to adjust all signal timing that has been altered to meet the 600 vehicle per hour cap back to its original condition.*
- 3. Remove "no right turn" restriction for westbound traffic on National at Motor.*
