The "Palms Beautification" portion of the Council District 10 Real Property Trust Fund provides funding for beautification measures, which may be, but are not limited to landscaping, greenery and traffic calming in the Palms area of Council District 10.

There is a great need to assist Palms Elementary School in acquiring and installing two highly visible signs, drought resistant plants and wrought iron fencing to be displayed at the front of the school.

This effort is of special benefit for the residents of the City and for Council District 10 and deserves financial assistance from the City.

Sufficient funds are available in the "Palms Beautification" portion of the Council District 10 Real Property Trust Fund for this purpose.

I THEREFORE MOVE that \$5,000 in the "Palms Beautification" Account in the Council District 10 Real Property Trust Fund No. 692 be utilized to fund any aspect of the Palms Elementary School acquisition and installation of two highly visible signs, drought resistant plants and wrought iron fencing to be displayed at the front of the school.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be directed to prepare the necessary document(s) with, and/or payment(s) to, Palms Elementary Student Body, or any other agency or organization, as appropriate, in the above amount, for the above purpose, subject to the approval of the City Attorney, if needed; and that the Council member of the District be authorized to execute any such documents on behalf of the City.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be authorized to make any technical corrections, adjustments or clarifications to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
